What to Expect on Closing Day

Congratulations — You Made It to Closing Day!

Closing day is one of the most exciting moments in your home buying journey! It's the day you officially become a homeowner. You will be signing the final documents, receiving your keys, and celebrating one of life's biggest milestones. Congratulations! This guide will help you know what to expect, what to bring with you to closing, and what to do after the closing so your transition into your new home is smooth and stress-free.

	Confirm your appointment Double-check your closing date, time, and location with your agent or title company.
	Bring identification
	You'll need a government-issued photo ID (driver's license or passport).
♀ Kris cor	 Review the email from your lender for specific instructions regarding the amount you need to bring to closing and how you will need to bring/send it. If you need to bring more than \$10,000 to closing, the funds must be wired. You'll get the official wiring instructions directly from Crossroads Title. If the amount is less than \$10,000, you can bring a certified or cashier's check made payable to Crossroads Title for your closing costs or down payment. Be sure to write your new home address on the memo line of the check sti's Tip: Always call the title company directly before wiring funds to a firm their instructions and that they have received your funds.
	Review your closing disclosures
	Compare it to your original loan estimate to make sure everything matches.

DURING CLOSING

- You'll meet with your title company to sign all final loan and ownership documents.
- Your lender will confirm all funds have been received.
- Once everything is signed and funded, the home is officially yours!
- You'll receive your keys and any garage openers or codes.
